# CANADIAN COUNTY ADDENDUM #1 BID NUMBER 2014-#2

## (1) Amend "Notice To Potentials Bidders" Change Paragraph to read as follows;

Included is (1) map indicating the affected areas which are outlined in red within unincorporated Canadian County where the work will take place. The material to be picked up and disposed is a combination of vegetative, construction and what is generally called white debris referring to metals house hold appliances and possibly a small amount haz-mat products, etc.

#### (2) Amend paragraph 1, page NTB1 to read as Follows;

Notice is hereby given that <u>Canadian County</u> desires to receive sealed bids for the emergency removal of estimated 5,000 + or - Tons of storm related debris with the finale cost determined by actual scale weight. Prospective bidders may obtain Bidding Documents at the Canadian County Clerk's Office, 201 N. Choctaw Ave, El Reno, OK. 73036, and the Canadian County Website at <u>www.canadiancounty.org</u>

#### (3) Amend paragraph 2, page NTB1 to read as follows;

Bids will be received in the Office of the County Clerk, 201 N. Choctaw Ave, El Reno OK. by no later than 4:00 pm, on Friday July 26, 2013. Bids shall be based upon the Plans and Specifications and other Bidding Documents. The Canadian County Board of Commissioners may issue addenda as may be necessary in the best interest of the public and Canadian County. Addenda may amend the date and/or time for receipt of bids or any specification, item, document or requirement.

#### (4) Amend Paragraph 4, page NTB1 to read as follows

All Bids timely received will be opened and reviewed by the Canadian County Board of Commissioners at their regular scheduled meeting on July 29, 2013 at 9:30 am at the Canadian County Courthouse, 201 N. Choctaw Ave., El Reno, OK. 73036. The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to recommend that the board waive immaterial defects and irregularities. Canadian County is an equal opportunity employer, we highly recommend and encourage small and minority business along with women's business enterprises and labor surplus area firms to participate, and reserves the right to not award this project based solely on the lowest bidding participant. Canadian County will make the award to a responsible contractor possessing the ability to perform successfully under the terms and conditions as defined in the Scope of Work along with the proposed bid. Consideration will be given to such matters as contractor integrity, compliance with public policy, record of past performance, and financial and technical resources.

## (5) Amend "Instruction to Bidders" Page ITB6, Paragraph 4.2.2 (date) to read as follows;

## (7) Amend Page SOW5, paragraph 4.2 to read as follows;

Eligible debris to be removed shall be Included in the unit price per ton or as indicated on Bid Schedule.

- The debris must present a HEALTH & SAFETY threat to the general public or to the users of an eligible facility.
- The debris must be the direct result of the declared event.
- The debris must be the legal responsibility of the eligible applicant.
- Trees with 50% or more of the "crown" broken out shall be removed by cutting the trees at ground level. "Crown" includes all green branches and the top.
- Hanger's two inches or greater in diameter, are eligible and shall be removed if they pose a danger.
- An uprooted tree with exposed roots shall be removed in its entirety, and the stump hole shall be back-filled by the contractor or applicant with compatible material.

- Standing, dead trees are not eligible for removal.
- Trees on private property which are leaning toward the road at a 30 degree or greater angle, and are at risk of falling and are of sufficient size to threaten the roadway or will fall across a fence line shall be removed by cutting the tree at the fence line or at the edge of the right-of-way.
- Trees that have a split trunk or broken branches that expose the heartwood are also eligible.

#### (8) Amend Page SOW10, paragraph 11.1 to read as follows;

Prior to signing of contract, contractor agrees to furnish the County with all applicable certificates of insurance. Within 24 hours following signing of contract, contractor shall provide copies of insurance policies including all endorsements. In addition, a payment and performance bond equal to 100% of (bid per ton X the estimated tonnage of debris) as identified on the "NOTICE TO BIDDERS" (page NTB1) is required within 24 hours of award of the contract. The contractor shall be able to cover expenses associated with a major recovery operation prior to the initial payment and between subsequent payments as well as the aforementioned bonds and insurance. Contractor mobilization costs will not be paid if the contractor is unable to obtain bonding.

## (9) Amend "Agreement" Page A1 (4) to read as follows;

The CONTRACTOR agrees to perform all of the work described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS and comply with the terms therein for the sum of \$ or as indicated in the Bid Schedule not to exceed 10% of the estimated amount of 5.000 tons unless otherwise approved by an Official of Canadian County.

## (10) Amend "AGREEMENT" PAGE A2 (6) to read as follows;

The OWNER will pay the CONTRACTOR upon satisfactory completion and invoiced of work performed for the removal of all acceptable storm related debris as cost determined by the contractors bid amount per ton Based on actual scale weight per tickets not exceed more than 10% of the estimated 5,000 tons unless otherwise approved by a Canadian County Official. Invoice shall be submitted to the Canadian County Emergency Manager for review and placed on the agenda to be approved by the Canadian County Board of County Commissioner at the earliest regularly scheduled meeting. Payment will be issued within (30) thirty days upon approval unless otherwise agreed upon by both parties.
