

To do any extra work not covered by the following schedule of prices or stipulated lump sum price which may be ordered by the Engineer and to accept as full compensation therefor such prices as may be agreed upon in writing by the Engineer and the Contractor in accordance with Section 108.04 of the General Provisions.

The Contractor shall take out and maintain public liability insurance in accordance with Section 106.25 of the General Provisions of the Specifications. A copy of said Specifications is now on file in the Office of the County Clerk.

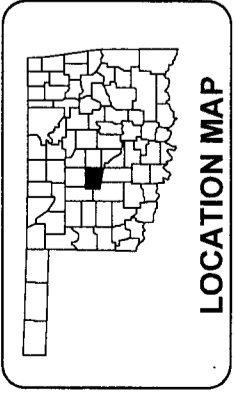

BRIDGE "B" EVANS ROAD (NS-287) OVER TRIBUTARY TO UNCLE JOHNS CREEK

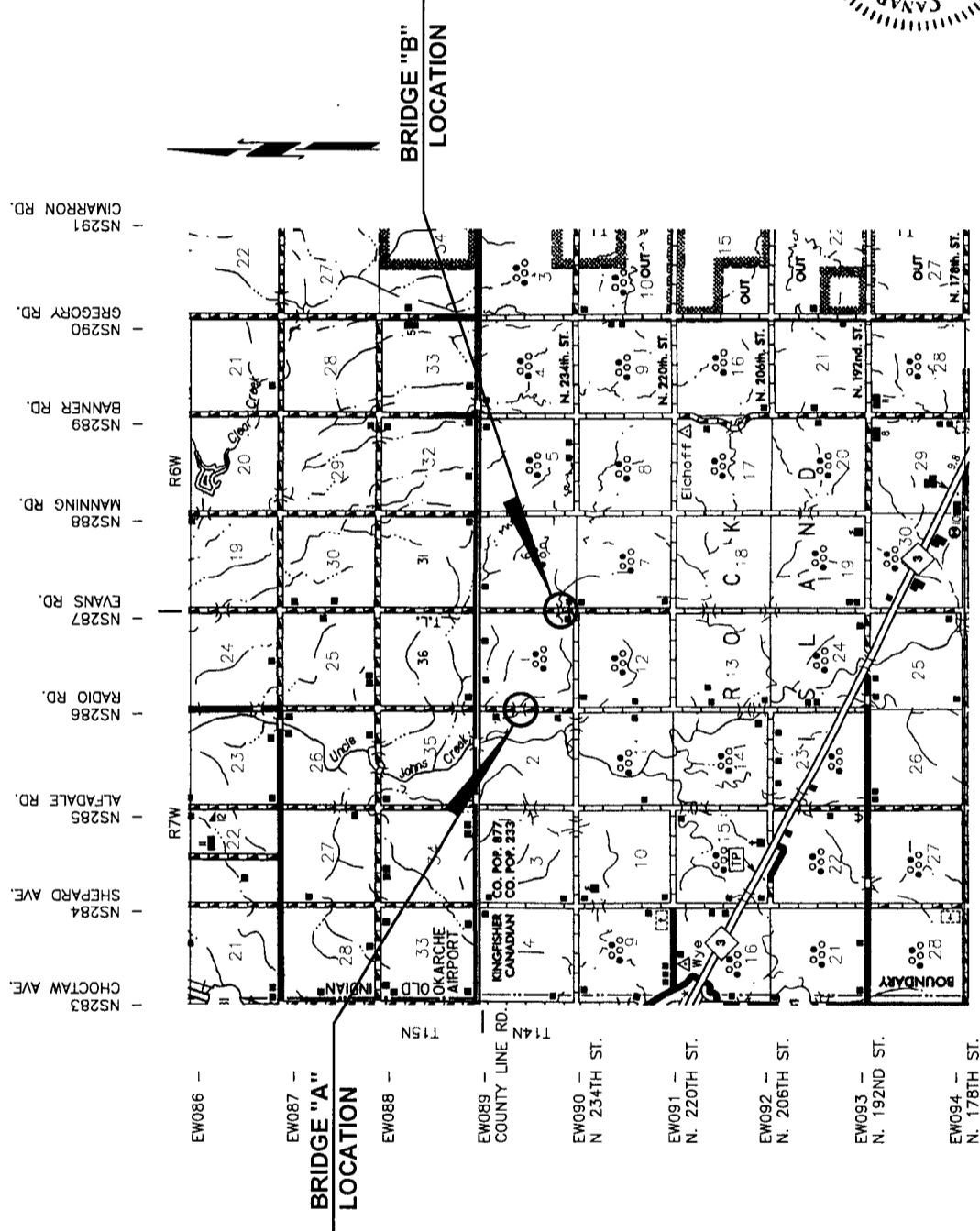

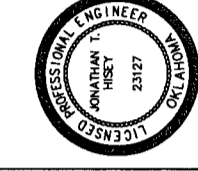

SPECIFICATIONS - COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE 2009 OKLAHOMA STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION, EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY THE PLANS.

VERIFICATION OF EXISTING CONDITIONS - THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR FULLY UNDERSTANDING THE NATURE OF THE WORK AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE WORK WILL BE PERFORMED.

MATERIALS - ALL MATERIAL MUST BE NEW AND SHALL BE DELIVERED TO CANADIAN COUNTY DISTRICT NO. 1 OR THE JOB SITE AS DIRECTED BY CANADIAN COUNTY DISTRICT NO. 1. PROVIDE FOR H-PILES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASTM A572 GRADE 50. PROVIDE STRUCTURAL STEEL FOR ROLLED STEEL BEAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASTM A709 GRADE 50. PROVIDE STRUCTURAL STEEL FOR ALL ANGLES, CHANNELS AND STEEL PLATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASTM A709 GRADE 36. PROVIDE WELDED STUDS OR CHANNEL HEADERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASTM A108, GRADE 1015, 1018 OR 1020.

REMOVAL OF EXISTING BRIDGE - CANADIAN COUNTY WILL REMOVE THE EXISTING BRIDGE.

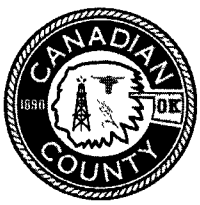
