1. Exception to AASHTO T59: Bring the temperature on the lower thermometer slowly to 350°F plus or minus 10°F. Maintain this temperature for 20 minutes. Complete the total distillation in 60 plus or minus 5 minutes.
2. For modifications for Polymer Properties testing, refer to Appendix A Test Modifications.
3. The emulsion supplier shall receive quarterly certificates of analysis from both the polymer and rejuvenating agent manufacturers. The COAs will be provided to the agency upon request.
4. The following process modifications and considerations should be used for this test to insure repeatable and applicable results:
 - a. Section 8 may be skipped for most rejuvenators, as most products will fall under "category A", as per the standard method.
 - b. Section 10.21- The use of anhydrous sodium sulfate, as described in this step, is unnecessary and may lead to error due to the propensity to pass through the filter paper, and artificially increasing the PCA extract yield.
 - c. Modify Section 10.3: Mix the contents by swirling or shaking the separating funnel. Adding 100mL of DMSO pre-equilibrated with cyclohexane and 50mL of Toluene.
 - d. Most rejuvenators will have sufficiently high viscosity necessitating following the provisions of section 10.31.1.
 - e. Note for section 10.4: Extract at a temperature of (23±2) °C by gently swirling and inverting for approximately 1 minute. (Vigorous shaking and agitation, as stated in the method, may lead to the formation of a relatively stable dispersion, resulting in a significant increase in time necessary for resolving the solution.
5. The emulsion supplier shall receive quarterly certificates of analysis from both the polymer and rejuvenating agent manufacturers. The COAs will be provided to the agency upon request.
6. The emulsion supplier shall receive quarterly certificates of analysis from both the polymer and rejuvenating agent manufacturers. The COAs will be provided to the agency upon request.
