(hereinafter called the "OWNER"), at Canadian County Clerk's Office, 201 N Choctaw Ave. El Reno, Oklahoma 73036 until **9:00 a.m.** (Local Time) on **Monday, January 9, 2023**. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud according to agenda items at the Board of County Commissioner of Canadian County at the regular meeting at 9:00 AM on Monday, January 9, 2023 in the Public Meeting Room in the County Courthouse at 201 N Choctaw Ave. El Reno, Oklahoma 73036.

Each BID must be submitted to: Canadian County Clerk, at 201 N Choctaw Ave. El Reno, Oklahoma 73036. The following information **MUST** be affixed to the **FRONT** of your mailing, or overnight envelope: **SEALED BID, NAME OF ITEM, CLOSING DATE AND TIME. Bids received without this information affixed will be rejected.**

All BIDS must be made on the required BID form. All blank spaces for BID prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, and the BID form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Only one Copy of the BID form is required.

The OWNER may waive any informalities or minor defects or reject any and all BIDS. Any BID may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of BIDS or authorized postponement thereof. **Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours before time specified and Bids received after the time set for opening Bids will not be considered and will be returned unopened.** No BIDDER may withdraw a BID within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Should there be reasons why the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period; the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the OWNER and the BIDDER.

BIDDERS must satisfy themselves of the accuracy of the estimated quantities in the BID schedule by examination of the site and a review of the drawings and specifications including ADDENDA. After BIDS have been submitted, the BIDDER shall not assert that there was a misunderstanding concerning the quantities of WORK or of the nature of the WORK to be done.

The OWNER shall provide to BIDDERS prior to BIDDING, all information which is pertinent to, and delineates and describes, the land owned and rights-of-way acquired or to be acquired.

The project is located in Canadian County, District 1, Oklahoma, and will be subject to all laws, ordinances, terms and conditions of Canadian County, District 1, Oklahoma, and under the sole jurisdiction of Canadian County, District 1, Oklahoma.

The CONTRACT DOCUMENTS contain the provisions required for the construction of the PRODUCT. Information obtained from an officer, agent, or employee of the OWNER or any other person shall not affect the risks or obligations assumed by the CONTRACTOR or relieve the contractor from fulfilling any of the conditions of the contract.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond payable to the OWNER for 5% (five percent) of the total amount of the bid. A certified check may be used in lieu of the bid bond. No bid security is required if bid is \$7,500.00 or less. As soon as the bid prices have been compared, the OWNER will return the bonds of all except the three lowest and best responsible bidders. The bid bond of the successful bidder will be retained until the Performance Bond, Statutory Bond and Certificate of Insurance have been executed and approved, after which it will be returned. The bid security of the two remaining unsuccessful Bidders will be returned after the successful Bidder has entered into a contract and has furnished the required bonds and insurance.

A Performance Bond, Statutory Bond in the amount of 100% (one hundred percent) of the Contract Price with a corporate surety approved by the OWNER will be required for the faithful performance of the Contract.

The OWNER should award a contract to the lowest and/or best responsible bidder or bidders within sixty (60) calendar days after bid opening. The OWNER may extend the award period not to exceed fifteen (15) calendar days by formal recorded action and for good cause.

The party to whom the contract is awarded will be required to execute the Agreement and obtain the Performance Bond, Statutory Bond and Certificate of Insurance within fourteen (14) calendar days from the date when Notice of Award is delivered to the Bidder. The Notice of Award shall be accompanied by the necessary Agreement and Bond forms. In the failure of the Bidder to execute the Agreement, the OWNER may consider the Bidder in default in which case the Bid Bond accompanying the proposal shall become the property of the OWNER.

The OWNER within fourteen (14) calendar days of receipt of acceptable Agreement, Bonds and Certificate of Insurance signed by the party to whom the Agreement was awarded shall sign the Agreement and return to such party an executed duplicate of the Agreement. Should the OWNER not execute the Agreement within such period, the BIDDER may by WRITTEN NOTICE withdraw the signed Agreement. Such NOTICE of withdrawal shall be effective upon receipt of the NOTICE by the OWNER.

The Notice to Proceed shall be issued by the OWNER within fifteen (15) calendar days of the execution of the Agreement, approval of Bonds and approval of the Certificate of Insurance. Should there be reasons why the Notice to Proceed cannot be issued within such period; the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the OWNER and CONTRACTOR. If the NOTICE TO PROCEED has not been issued within the fifteen (15) day period or within the period mutually agreed upon, the CONTRACTOR may terminate the Agreement without further liability on the part of either party.

Canadian County Commissioner, Marc Hader, is requesting sealed bids for the Britton Rd. Rehabilitation,

- **Base Bid: 2" asphalt overlay and patching, including a 400 foot segment of total reconstruction, and striping for 4.00 miles from Manning Rd. to Richland Rd. and 0.50 miles from Hwy. 81 going east.**
- **Add Alt #1: Jones Rd. 2" asphalt overlay and patching for 0.25 miles from Hwy. 81 going east and 0.55 miles from Hwy. 81 going west.**
- **Add Alt #2: 234th St. 1" mill and level, 3" asphalt overlay and patching, and striping for 0.34 miles from Hwy. 81 to Stroh Ave.**

Contractor will furnish all necessary equipment and labor, along with all warning signs and liability insurance for safety; and prevent any liability against Canadian County while work is in progress. All work will be subject to inspections by Canadian County and work performance bond. Work can begin when all bonds are on file in the Canadian County Clerk's Office and when the Canadian County Commissioner is ready.

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC: All work shall be performed in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), current edition. The successful bidder shall furnish and place all warning devices and other traffic control devices required to direct, control and protect the traveling public during the complete process of the bridge construction.

INDEMNIFICATION: The Contractor hereby agrees to assume all risks and responsibilities inherent in performing the contracted services and does hereby agree to defend, hold harmless, indemnify, release and forever discharge Canadian County and any of its officers, agents, employees, volunteers and servants from and against any all claims, demands, and actions, causes of action, losses liabilities, or expenditures of any kind, including court cost and expenses, accruing or resulting from any suits or damage of any character resulting from injuries, damages, or death sustained by any person or persons, or property, by virtue of the performance of this agreement either directly or indirectly.

BONDS: All bids must contain a letter of intent from a bonding company authorized to do business in the State of Oklahoma stating its willingness to bond the Contractor pursuant to the terms of any contract resulting from the Invitation to Bid.

- The contractor shall procure and maintain, at the Contractor's expense, a Performance Bond for the period of the contract project.

means, methods, sequence, techniques or procedures necessary for performing, superintending and coordinating the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents and any health or safety precautions required by any regulatory agencies. Canadian County and its personnel have no authority to exercise any control over any construction contractor or its employees in connection with their work or any health or safety programs or procedures. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for jobsite and worker safety and warrants that this intent shall be carried out.

- **IN NO WAY WILL Canadian County BE RESPONSIBLE IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT.**

SEVERABILITY: Any term or provision of this AGREEMENT found to be invalid under any applicable statute or rule of law shall be deemed omitted and the remainder of this AGREEMENT shall remain in full force and effect.
