Following increases to the estimates of needs during discussion for COWRA, building repairs, performance audits and Free Fair, the preliminary estimates of needs are \$18,208,694.00. The initial budget deficit to be balanced is \$818,879.00. No action was necessary at this time.

At 1:01pm, Ramsey reconvened the meeting in the County Clerk's office.
