Bearden called the meeting to order at 1:42 p.m. and announced that a quorum was present.

McCloud moved to accept the minutes of the November 1, 2010 Regular Meeting; Richey seconded. Voting aye: Austin, Bearden, McCloud, Renbarger, and Richey.

There were no comments from the public.

The Board tabled agenda item 4 for Cimarex well Donald 1-9H due to Cimarex needing to delay the item.

The Board considered approval of the permit application for Devon Gas Services, L.P. to bury a natural gas pipeline in Section 25 of T13N R9W (District 3). Renbarger moved to approve with the creek bored under; Austin seconded. Voting aye: Austin, Bearden, McCloud, Renbarger, and Richey. Permit #043-010.

The Board considered approval of the permit application for Arleta Askew to construct a barn in the NE/4 Section 9 T12N R6W, 16440 W Foreman Rd (District 1). Austin moved to approve; Renbarger seconded. Voting aye: Austin, Bearden, McCloud, Renbarger, and Richey. Permit #044-010.

Under New Business, Brandley informed the Board of her efforts with the Oklahoma Floodplain Managers Association to standardize oil and gas floodplain management across the state.

Renbarger moved to adjourn; Richey seconded. The Board adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
