The Board considered approval of the permit application for DCP Midstream, LP to bury a natural gas pipeline and meter run in the N/2 Section 26 and the NE/4 Section 27 T11N R8W, District 2. Richey moved to approve with a flood protection fence at the meter run; Austin seconded. Voting aye: Austin, Bearden, McLoud, Richey. Motion passed. Permit #024-012.

McLoud moved and Richey seconded to table item 6, Wild's carport application. Voting aye: Austin, Bearden, McLoud, Richey. Motion passed.

Under New Business, Brandley stated that Cimarex was considering moving the Maggie 1-22 SWD well by a few hundred feet and that the Board can consider that at the next meeting.
