Denwalt moved, seconded by Brooks to approve a maintenance agreement between Financial Products Corp and the County Treasurer. Voting aye, Denwalt, Brooks and Young.

Young moved, seconded by Denwalt to approve appointments of employment of Thomas J. Key as part-time jailer, and Richard L. LeVann as Deputy Sheriff for the County Sheriff's Office. Voting aye, Denwalt, Brooks and Young.

Brooks moved, seconded by Denwalt to approve two Sheriff's Claims for Board of County Prisoners. Voting aye, Denwalt, Brooks and Young.

Young moved to appoint Sharon Dill as County Court Clerk, Denwalt seconded after stating he was tired of the far-fetched rumors last week that he was to be appointed. Denwalt stated the Board delayed the appointment because they were concerned that an employee in the Court Clerk's Office had threatened Dill to be appointed first deputy once Dill became Court Clerk, or she would work against her election in two years. Denwalt stated he visited with Dill early this morning and was satisfied she would not be intimidated by such threats and she would be strong enough to operate the Court Clerk's Office to the best of her ability.
