Board of County Commissioners Meeting
January 3, 2000

The Board of Canadian County Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. in the Public Meeting Room. Those persons present were: Monty Keely, Stanley Wallace, Mary Rother, Susan Toth, Pat Hammert, Lynne Stevenson, Mark Lagaly and Gary Shidell.

Keely called the meeting to order.

Wallace moved, seconded by Keely to approve the minutes of the December 27, 1999 meeting. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

Wallace moved, seconded by Keely to approve appropriations. There were no transfers to approve. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

Under comments from the Public, Gary Shidell reports to the Board that Y2K was uneventful, there were no glitches reported, although there was a bomb threat called in at Yukon. Shidell also reports that the Safe School Program is going well. The Program should be in El Reno January 20, 2000. This program provides education for bomb threats, shootings, tornadoes and any other emergency or disaster related incidents.

Keely moved, seconded by Wallace to approve the Summary Report of Consumable Items for District #3. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

Wallace moved, seconded by Keely to approve the Addendum to Maintenance Agreement between Canadian County and CPS Systems, Inc., for maintenance. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

Wallace moved, seconded by Keely to approve the Designation of Requisitioning and Receiving Officers for the District Attorney's Bogus Check Fee Account. Mike Gahan is the requisitioning officer. The receiving agents are as follows: Carole Bocox, Garfield County; RexAnn Kretchmar, Grant County; Marla MaGee, Canadian County; Ann Martin, Blaine County and Marsha Mueggenborg for Kingfisher County. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

Wallace moved, seconded by Keely to appoint the following persons to the Flood Plain Board. Carl Richey will serve a one year term for District #1, and Dale Phenis will serve a two year term for District #2. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

There was no further discussion or any action needed pertaining to the Flood Plain Office/Board.

Wallace moved, seconded by Keely to approve the State-Local Disaster Assistance Agreement FEMA 1271-DR-OK (HMGP) Safe Room Rebate Program by and between the State of Oklahoma and Canadian County. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

Wallace reports that plans for the new parking lot north of the Judicial Building have been returned and a bid date will be set up January 4, 2000.

Keely moved, seconded by Wallace to award Bid #1999-00-12 Tires and Tubes for District #2 to the low bidders with the exception of the grader radial tires, and these will be awarded to the Michelin low bid. Keely states he is currently running Michelin tires on his graders now, and is pleased with the performance of these tires and wishes to stay with the Michelin radial's for the graders. Voting aye, Keely and Wallace.

The Commissioners gave the following reports:

Wallace reports that last week he let his roadmen use any of their excess compensation and vacation time, this left 4 or 5 employees along with the Road Foreman at District #1. December 28th Wallace met with ACCO discussing the state budget process for statewide programs and the rest of the week was spent working on office paperwork.

Keely reports he had the same type of work crew at District #2 as was at District #1. Keely reports his aunt passed away this weekend and his mother-in-law is in ICU, and also a friend was in an accident and is also in ICU. Keely wishes everyone a Happy New Year.
