## August 25, 2003

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Cleveland County Budget Board was called to order this 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2003, in the conference room of the County Office Building by Vice-Chairman Denise Heavner. Roll was called by Dorinda Harvey, County Clerk/Secretary and those present were:

Dorinda Harvey, County Clerk, had passed out two different documents, the first one being the new insurance rates for calendar year 2003 and the one from last calendar year 2002 so the officials could make a comparison. Mrs. Harvey stated that the rates were a little lower than what was estimated.

The other document that was given was information on the optional retirement contribution for regular employees' that goes into effect January, 2003. Mrs. Harvey explained the new contribution and stated that the forms would be available in her office in October.

Denise Heavner, County Assessor, stated that she has the valuations and that the county is up about \$54 million from last year, that would be an additional \$540,000.00 more for the county. The valuation total for the entire county is \$966,633,407.00.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Bill Graves moved that the meeting be adjourned. Dorinda Harvey seconded the motion.
