Chairman Skinner asked Sheriff's Beggs, if he had any commit. Sheriff Beggs stated he didn't think he did, he thinks he understand what is being said and he doesn't have any kind of a problem with it.

After more discussion and input Sandra DeSelms moved, seconded by Denise Heavner, to approve to Pay Courthouse Security Deputies out of Courthouse Security Account (General Fund Account) effective October 1, 2005.
