

December 11, 2006

Dorinda Harvey, County Clerk repressed her concern about the number of keys the present District Attorney's Office has for the west parking lot and requested that when the new District Attorney takes office in January the keys be divided equally.

Rhonda Hall asked if the west parking lot was going to be marked so people would know where to park.

Tammy Howard stated the stencils came in last week and as soon as the weather clears up that will get done and she thinks that Dan Cary (Safety Director) will re-issue a memo as to who is to park in what space.

Several Officials have had complaints about the Sheriff's Office taking up the parking meters on the west side of the building.

There being no further business to come before the board, Dorinda Harvey moved that the meeting be adjourned. Rhonda Hall seconded the motion.
