Representatives are here to ask the Board to set a hearing between twenty (20) and forty (40) days from this date to hear from anyone who might what to protest the formation of the fire protection district. The County Clerk will publish a notice of that hearing but Mr. McDanel's suggestion is that a date be chosen that will coincide with the Board's regular meeting.
