## October 15, 2002

Dwaine Rhodes explained that the west parking lot would be used for the equipment for the construction. He also explained the time frame in which the project would be completed, beginning with the presentation today to the date of substantial

completion July 1, 2005. Mr. Rhodes also went over the cost estimate breakdown and explained to the Board that the cost estimate would be reviewed from time to time and that he would be returning to the Board for approval of an updated cost review and with recommendations on alternates to bid.

George Skinner asked if the time schedule could be moved up.

Mr. Rhodes stated that he thinks they could look at that.
