Leroy Krohmer, Chairman, called an Emergency Meeting of the Cleveland County Board of Commissioners to order this 10th day of February, 2003, at 9:500 A.M. and those present were:

Mike McDanel, Assistance District Attorney, explained the following to the board. The sheriff's office has custody of a female inmate, who will be delivering a baby in April. At present she is being held on a quarter million dollar bond, in which she is expected not to make that bond. The county is therefore responsible for her medical treatment and care while in custody. The sheriff has made arrangements with the Department of Corrections through an Interlocal Agreement to accept this inmate at their facility where she will have appropriate continuing medical care and treatment due to complications and difficulties.

DeWayne Beggs added that this person is a flight risk and the District Attorney's Office does not feel like we can "O.R." this person out, in this particular case this person needs to stay here. In doing so we have tried to work out an agreement with D.O.C. and they are willing to contract with us to where we can put her in their medical facilities at \$24.00 per day.

Upon the recommendation of Mike McDanel, Bill Graves moved, seconded by George Skinner, to approve the Interlocal Agreement with the Department of Corrections for taking care of the female inmate in their medical facilities until she can return to jail or what ever her future holds.
