Upon the request of Tammy Howard, Purchasing Agent, Bill Graves moved, seconded by Leroy Krohmer, to award County Bid # HD-1199 – The purchase and installation of cluster workstations for the new Health Department Building located at 250 12th Avenue, N.E., Norman, Oklahoma to The Office Planning Group, Inc., in the amount of \$147,877.20. Ms. Howard stated that this was not the low bid but that the bids lower than this one either did not meet the specs or did not meet the time frame to move into the new office building. The vote was: Leroy Krohmer, yes; Bill Graves, yes. Motion carried.

Leroy Krohmer moved, seconded by Bill Graves, to rescind the approval of the Engineering Contract for County Bridge Improvement between the Board of County Commissioners and Engineering Services and Testing, Inc. The Contract is for Bridge replacement in District #3 on 96th Ave. between Slaughterville Rd. and Edge of the Earth Rd. (4 structures: 14N3200E1400007, 14N320E1400007, 14N3200E1330009, and a 15' roadway structure) and the bridge located on Bryant Rd. just west of 96th Ave. and bridge located on Lewis Rd. just west of 96th Ave. (2 structures 14E1340N3190009, 14E1390N3190009).
