June 14, 2005

Chairman Stockwell called for the Presentation by James Riddick, from Department of Corrections on GPS Monitoring.

Mr. Riddick presented the Council Members with literature about the company (Pro Tech) that the Department of Corrections uses for GPS monitoring. The Department of Corrections uses GPS on an early release program for non-violent, no violent crimes, no escape etc. Those offenders that are on work release status are allowed to go home early on GPS. The County Sheriff and local police departments are notified prior to their release. Currently there are about 180 on the program. Senate Bill 631 was pass and signed by the Governor this legislative session, which requires all sex offenders to be monitored basically the rest of their lives on this program. Mr. Riddick showed the Council one of the units, the actually tracking devise, the docking station
