October 17, 2005

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called to order this 17th day of October, 2005, in the conference room of the Cleveland County Fairgrounds, 605 E. Robinson, Norman, Oklahoma, by Chairman George Skinner. Roll was called by Dorinda Harvey, County Clerk/Secretary, and those present were:

The Board of County Commissioners of Cleveland County, #CIV-04-922T and that the designated representative of the Board have authority for a settlement of this matter in accordance with the contract or provision between the Board of Cleveland County Commissioner and ACCO (The Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma).
