Meeting the requirements of an Emergency as defined in 25 O. S §304.5 "...a situation involving injury to persons or injury and damage to public or personal property or immediate financial loss when the time requirements for public notice of a special meeting would make such procedures impractical and increase the likelihood of injury or damage or immediate financial loss", Chairman Leroy Krohmer called the Emergency Meeting of the Cleveland County Board of Commissioners to order this 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2006, in the conference room of the County Office Building for the purpose of closing due to weather conditions.
