August 6, 2007

The regular scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called to order this 6th day of August, 2007, in the conference room of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman George Skinner. Roll was called by Tammy Howard, County Clerk/Secretary and those present were:

George Skinner, Chairman Rusty Sullivan, Vice-Chairman Rod Cleveland, Member Tammy Howard, Secretary

Others present were: Christine Brannon, David Batton, F. DeWayne Beggs, Eddie Thomason, Neil Vickers, Melinda Duke, Denise Ellison, Peggy Laizure, Sylvia Martin, James Tyree, Daniel Clements and Jim Helm.

Chairman Skinner began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

After the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of July 30 2007, and there being no additions or corrections, Rod Cleveland moved that the minutes be approved. Rusty Sullivan seconded the motion.

The vote was: George Skinner, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes. Motion carried.

Chairman Skinner called for discussion, consideration, and/or action on the Jail Report from Neil Vickers.

Mr. Vickers stated during this reporting period the average population per day of the Cleveland County Detention Center was 217 prisoners. This average was 18 more than the previous week due to an increase in arrests. During this week the City of Norman averaged 5 municipal prisoners per day and the City of Moore averaged 4 prisoners per day. During this week's period the Sheriff's Office transported 4 prisoners to other jurisdictions after hearings were conducted in the Cleveland County Court System. Seven prisoners convicted in our court system were transported to the Department of Corrections to serve prison time. District Judges released three prisoners held for court costs and fines only after new terms were set. There are presently 27 defendants in the pre-trial release program and on electronic monitoring. During this past weekend from Friday until Monday morning, 91 people were arrested and booked into the detention center. Of the 91, 64 were held on state charges and 27 on municipal charges. On Monday morning, 34 of the 91 arrested remained in jail. Of the 91 arrested, 30 were held on alcohol related charges. Of the jail's population of 211 prisoners, 1 prisoner has been in our jail since 2005, 7 since 2006 and the remainder were arrested some time during this year. Mr. Vickers will continue to monitor the jail population and make recommendations as he can.

Rusty Sullivan moved to accept. Rod Cleveland seconded the motion.

Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to approve the Copy Cost Agreement and fee schedule between the Cleveland County Clerk's Office and First American Title & Trust Company for the amount of \$150.00 per month. Pursuant to Title 28, O.S.§ 32 as per the State Auditor and Inspector's Office. Agreement is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

Pursuant to Title 28, O.S.\s\ 32 as per the State Auditor and Inspector's Office. Agreement is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to approve the Agreement between Cleveland County Sheriff's Office and Maguire Disposal for weekly disposal at the Field Services Division in Slaughterville for \$30.00 per month. Agreement is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.
