## **MINUTES**

May 19, 2008

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called to order this 19th day of May, 2008, in meeting room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman George Skinner. Tammy Howard, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

Chairman Skinner began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Then to establish or set up a meeting with the representatives of the Trust and Cleveland County to resolve any remaining differences or defects in the present system or make new arrangements.

Chairman Skinner moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to accept and approve the recommendation of David Batton, Assistant District Attorney.
