Cleveland County agrees to provide funds in the amount of \$2,400.00 as contribution to the cooperative animal damage control program for the purpose to supplement the wildlife damage control travel and field expenses of the Wildlife Services Specialists. Contract period will be from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. Pursuant to Section 2 of Cooperative Agreement Number 1-10-00 date June 19, 1995. The vote was: George Skinner, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes, Rod Cleveland. Motion carried.

Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by George Skinner, to approve the Resolution to execute the Agreement establishing the program between the Board of County Commissioners and the Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma Self-Insurance Fund (Workers' Compensation Program) for the yearly amount of \$274,270.00. Policy coverage will be from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to approve the Amendment to the Common Area Maintenance Cost Sharing Agreement approved in the County Commissioner's Meeting on July 10, 2007 and amendment approved on January 22, 2008. The amendment changes the cost for Day Porter Services shared between the Cleveland County Public Facilities Authority, a Public Trust and Professional Properties of Oklahoma, LLC. The monthly fee will be amended from \$114.00 per month to \$300.00 per month to be paid by the Cleveland County Health Department for property located at 424 S. Eastern, Moore, OK.
