Upon the request of Melinda Duke, Purchasing Agent, Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by George Skinner, to award per the bid summary and where the low bidder is not awarded there is an explanation, County Bid #HWY-1410 – Non-Encumbered Contract for Bulk Oils, Lubricants & Antifreeze for the County Commissioners. The bid term will be from May 22, 2009 and ending on September 21, 2009.

Upon the request of Doug McKenzie, Administration Chief for the Sheriff's Office, Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by George Skinner, to award the bid to CDW Government, Inc., County Bid #SHE-1412 – Non-Encumbered Contract for the purchase of Laptop Computers & Accessories for the Sheriff's Office. This agreement shall be in effect for one (1) year, commencing from the bid award date through and including twelve (12) months, with the option to renew up to three (3) years on an annual basis.

Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by George Skinner, to approve the Service Agreement between the Cleveland County Sheriff's Office and Network Alarm Services, Inc. for monthly alarm system monitoring at \$24.95 per month for the Sheriff Office Annex located at 114 S. Peters, Norman, OK. The period will be from March 1, 2009 through March 1, 2010.

George Skinner moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to approve the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of Cleveland, Payne, Logan, Oklahoma, McClain, Garvin and Murray Counties for joint or cooperative action to perform any governmental service, activity or undertaking which the public agency is authorized by law to perform by establishing Circuit Engineering District 5 and desires use of the services through December 31, 2009.
