## **MINUTES**

## April 26, 2010

George Skinner moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 19, 2010.

George Skinner moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to approve the resolution relating to the incurring of indebtedness by the Trustees of the Cleveland County Educational Facilities Authority to be accomplished by the issuance of lease revenue bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness on a tax-exempt or taxable basis in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$65,000,000 to provide funds to Independent School District No. 29, Cleveland County, Oklahoma ("Norman Public Schools" or the "District") required to complete the acquisition, construction, equipping, repairing and remodeling of school buildings, acquiring school furniture, fixtures and equipment and acquiring and improving school sites; establish a reserve fund, capitalize interest and pay costs of issuance and all matters related thereto, including but not limited to the waiver of competitive bidding thereof; and declaring an emergency.
