May 17, 2010

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called to order this 17th day of May 2010, in meeting room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Rod Cleveland. Tammy Howard, Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:
