# BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S MINUTES

## February 7, 2011

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called to order this 7th day of February, 2011, in meeting room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Rusty Sullivan. Tammy Howard, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

George Skinner moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 31, 2011 and Emergency Meeting of January 31, 2011. The vote was: George Skinner, yes; Rod Cleveland; yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes. Motion Carried. After Motion and Vote taken Rod Cleveland asked if a correction could be made to the

Emergency Meeting Minutes of January 31, 2011. George Skinner moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to withdraw the 1<sup>st</sup> Motion and to approve the minutes with the amended corrections.

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Upon the request of Brenda Wakeman, Assistant Purchasing Agent, Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by George Skinner, to award to the low bidders per the bid summary for County Bid #HWY-1490 – Four-Months (4) Non-Encumbered Contract to provide Materials and Installation of Asphaltic Concrete Base and Surface Coarse (Hot Mix/Hot Laid Asphalt). The bid term will be from February 10, 2011 through June 9, 2011.

The initial term of the contract shall be until June 30, 2011 with the option to renew for up to an additional (3) three one-year consecutive terms not to exceed \$100,000.00 per twelve month period per GSA contract and sole source acquisition.
