

**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S
Minutes**

September 30, 2011

The special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called to order this 30th day of September, 2011, in meeting room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman George Skinner. Christine Brannon, Deputy County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

George Skinner moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan to approve an agreement with Oklahoma Energy Services, Inc., to supply natural gas to county buildings through use of an electronic flow meter as an energy and cost savings measure, agreement will be effective November 1, 2011 and be month to month. Monthly maintenance fee will be \$20.54. Gas savings projected to be approximately 30%. Skinner said the contract came to him too late to add to September 26, 2011 agenda and the deadline to take advantage of the savings was October 1, 2011.

The vote was: George Skinner, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes.
Motion carried.

Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by George Skinner, to approve an Interlocal Agreement with Cleveland County District Court for FY2011/2012 for pre-trial release services program through court approved providers. County to provide partial economic assistance not to exceed \$15,000.00 per month based on number of participants in supervision program. Batton said Judge Walkley had requested the program and it would help keep the jail population down and provide better protection of the residents of Cleveland County.

The vote was: Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes; George Skinner, yes.
Motion carried.

County resident Mike Anderson commended Skinner on his good service to the county and asked that he could do one more good thing and rescind the redistricting that was approved September 12, 2011. As a Slaughterville resident, he asked if the logistics of the road maintenance from the northwest part of the county to the southeast part would be a difficult proposition.

Rod Cleveland moved to rescind the redistricting plan adopted on September 12, 2011. The motion died for lack of a second.

Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by George Skinner to approve an amended resolution regarding the redistricting plan previously adopted on September 12, 2011 to include legal descriptions of boundaries for the commissioners' districts. Cleveland asked legal counsel if the 20 days to file a protest would begin today.

Mike Anderson and Larry Iovan addressed the board about redistricting.

Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by George Skinner to approve an amended resolution regarding the redistricting plan previously adopted on September 12, 2011 to include legal descriptions of boundaries for the commissioners’ districts. Cleveland asked legal counsel if the 20 days to file a protest would begin today.

The vote was: George Skinner, yes; Rod Cleveland, no; Rusty Sullivan, yes.

Motion carried.

Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by George Skinner, to adjourn.
