The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called to order this 27th day of February, 2012, in meeting room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman George Skinner. Tammy Howard, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to Approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of February 21, 2012. The vote was: Cleveland, yes; Sullivan, yes. Motion carried.
