The Health Department will pay \$16.00 per hour for coordination services and \$0.555 per mile as per the State Travel Reimbursement Act not to exceed \$6,255.00. The contract is to be effective July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.

for services of up to three instructional assistants. Travel related to training for instructional assistants will be billed at a rate of \$0.555 per mile and shall not exceed costs authorized by the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
