BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S MINUTES

SEPTEMBER 9, 2013

Perry L. Brooks, DDS, explained that he has been involved in foreign missions and is part of a ministry group called 1040i that is concerned with healthcare, education and clean drinking water in third world countries. Dr. Brooks led in prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners was called to order this 9th day of September 2013 in the conference room of the County Office Building by Chairman Rusty Sullivan. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

After the reading of the minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 3, 2013 and there being no additions or corrections, Darry Stacy moved that the minutes be approved. The motion was seconded by Rod Cleveland.

A. Old Business:

 Upon the recommendation of Assistant Purchasing Agent Keri Lyles, Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to table for one week the awarding and/or rejecting of the bids for BID# - HWY-1627 – Four (4) month Non-Encumbered Contract for Bulk Oils, Lubricants & Antifreeze for the County Commissioners.
