# MINUTES

# **NOVEMBER 4, 2013**

He said that Mr. Williams did an excellent job for Cleveland County and wished him much success in his new occupation. Darry Stacy recognized Stephen Koranda, who served his first official day last Friday, as executive director of the Cleveland County Fairgrounds. Chairman Sullivan said that Monday, November 11, 2013 is Veteran's Day and a ceremony is being held to recognize and honor all veterans at the Wal-Mart Store on the east side of Norman. The ceremony will begin at 9:00 a.m.
