## **NOVEMBER 18, 2013**

# E. Commissioner's Discussions regarding County Business:

Commissioner District #1 Rod Cleveland said that he watched a demonstration of a new type of sealant being used in Pottawatomie County with Randy Thomas, Commissioner #2, on six miles of road on Hardesty Road. Commissioner Cleveland said that of those six miles he observed them surfacing 1.5 mile of road. He learned that the difference in their sealant from other sealants is a mixture of a limestone crush instead of a sand mix and their finished product actually makes a hard surface. He said that the demo was interesting and added that it will be equally as interesting to know the outcome.

Commissioner Cleveland said that there is to be an interim study next month with Jason Murphey's Committee on Modernization of County Government. He will be attending that meeting on December 16, 2013. The committee wants to look at the education or classes for county officers.

Commissioner Stacy said that he would like to see more Webinar classes being utilized. Tammy Belinson said that she spoke with Notie Lansford, Professor and Extension Economist, OSU County Training Program, who has stated that it is their goal to have more Webinar Classes for next year.
