BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S

MINUTES

FEBRUARY 24, 2014

Linda Atkins led in prayer and pledge of allegiance.

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners was called to order this 24th day of February 2014 in the meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Rusty Sullivan. Roll was called by Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, and those present were:

Others present were: Assistant District Attorney Heather Darby, Assistant District Attorney Jim Robertson, Bryant Rain, Stephen Koranda, Andy Rieger, George Mauldin, Melinda Duke, Keri Lyles, Rhett Burnett, Christine Cartmell and Linda Atkins.

After the reading of the minutes of the Regular Meeting of February 18, 2014, and there being no additions or correction, Darry Stacy moved that the minutes be approved. Rod Cleveland seconded the motion.

The vote was: Rusty Sullivan, yes; Darry Stacy, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes. Motion carried.

A. Old Business:

1. Upon the recommendation of Assistant Purchasing Agent Keri Lyles, Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to **table** for one week the awarding and/or rejecting of bids for **BID# - HWY-1656** – Six month (6) Non-Encumbered Contract for Tires and Tubes. The bid term will be from March 5, 2014 through September 4, 2014.

2. Upon the recommendation of Purchasing Agent Melinda Duke, Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to **award** to Kent's Custom Cars & Truck Inc., in the amount of \$15,000.00 for **BID# - SHE-1658** – The purchase and delivery of one (1), 1990 model, or newer, 53 ft. Command Post Trailer for the Cleveland County Sheriff.

1. Safety Director and Emergency Manager George Mauldin recommended that due to current conditions to not call for a burn ban at the present time. Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to **strike** the **Resolution** from the agenda regarding the adoption/cancellation of a county Burn Ban as per the Oklahoma Statute Title 2, Section 16-26 B.

The report lists the owners of record of unclaimed mineral interest and shall be kept by the County Clerk for public viewing.

Rhett Burnett said that this is a pilot program that reads license plates, collects data of uninsured motorist, and will notify CCSO of motorist with outstanding arrest warrants.
