B. Old Business:

Upon the recommendation of Purchasing Agent Melinda Duke, Darry Stacy moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to award as per bid summary for Bid #HWY-1686 – Non-Encumbered Contract to provide S4 and S5 Asphalt Material. The bid term will be from bid award date through February 10, 2015. The vote was: Darry Stacy, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, abstain. Motion carried.

C. Items of Business:

- Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to approve the Contract between the Cleveland County Sheriff's Office and Moore Norman Technology for 2 deputies, administrative fees, fuel and maintenance on vehicles at an annual fee of \$111,252.96. Term is July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. The vote was: Darry Stacy, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, abstain. Motion carried.
- Upon the recommendation of Assistant District Attorney Jim Robertson, Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to approve the Franchise Agreement between Cleveland County and CoxCom, Inc., d/b/a Cox Communications. Term is from date of approval through August 1, 2019. The vote was: Darry Stacy, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes. Motion carried.
- **3.** Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to **approve** the **Resolution** to dispose of the following equipment for Cleveland County District One. This is to reconcile their equipment list and remove (1) item that was stolen and (1) item that was permanently attached to a traded piece of equipment prior:

a. D403-20 Portable Welder (gas)b. D354-46 Dump Body ½ Round

4. Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to **approve** the **Contract** between Cleveland County District 1, Cleveland County District 2 and Del Nero Communications Management, LLC for Internet Service. Term is July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. Monthly rates are as follows:

a. District 1- \$100.00 per month, Plan for Business 3+ users
b. District 2- \$50.00 per month, 2Mbps Plan 1-2 users

5. Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to **approve** the **Contract** between Cleveland County District 3 and Del Nero Communications Management, LLC for

Internet Service. Term is July 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014. Monthly rates are as follows:

a. District 3- \$50.00 per month, 2Mbps Plan 1-2 users The vote was: Darry Stacy, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes. Motion carried.

- 6. Darry Stacy moved, seconded by Rusty Sullivan, to approve the Application for Permit from Enerfin Resources Company, Inc. to install and construct by "Slick Bore" 6-inch Natural Gas Steel Pipeline; Begin at Corners Common to the Northeast Corner of Section 25, 8N-1E, Cleveland County, Ok., and the Northwest Corner of Section 30, 8N-2E, Pottawatomie County, Ok.; thence, south along the dividing lines of said Sections for a distance of Sixty-seven (67') Feet to the POB; thence, from said POB, the "Slick Bore" Pipeline installation in an easterly westerly direction across and beneath the Right-of-Way limits of Pottawatomie Road. The vote was: Darry Stacy, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes. Motion carried.
- 7. Rusty Sullivan moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to approve the Resolution approving and authorizing the Cleveland County Public Facilities Authority (herein the "Authority") to issue certain obligations to be loaned to Gordon Jensen Health Care Associates, Inc., as are herein fully described as is required by the provisions of 60 O.S. Section 176(E); in one or more series to provide financing of a total aggregate principal amount not to exceed Fifteen Million Dollars (\$15,000,000) on a taxable or tax-exempt basis for the financing of the acquisition and demolition of an existing nursing home and construction and equipping of a new nursing home in place thereof located at 501 East Robinson, Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma and paying of costs of issuance related thereto, capitalizing interest if any and establishing related reserves, authorizing the signing off on the Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act ("TEFRA") hearing based on certification of designated representative with regard to the issuance of the obligations described herein; and waiving competitive bidding with respect to the sale of such obligations as is required by 60 O.S. 176(F); and approving and ratifying all actions of the Authority taken on June 25, 2013 and July 7, 2014. - 8. Upon the recommendations of Assistant District Attorney Jim Robertson and Emergency Manager and Safety Director George Mauldin, Darry Stacy moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to **accept** the pending court order and will act accordingly once it is **received** regarding an abandoned trailer at the corner of HOLLOWOAK RD. and SUNDANCE LN., and action related thereto. The vote was: Darry Stacy, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Rusty Sullivan, yes. Motion carried.

9. Darry Stacy moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to **approve** the **premium** payment options for ACCO-SIG in 6 month increments which is Option No. 2 on their payment schedule.
