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## **B.** Old Business:

Darry Stacy moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, to strike from the agenda the Resolution approving and authorizing the issuance by the Cleveland County Justice Authority of up to Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) in bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness according to a plan of financing, on a taxable or tax-exempt basis in one or more series to provide funds to currently refund the \$30,410,000 Cleveland County Justice Authority Sales Tax Revenue Bonds (Cleveland County Detention Facility Project) Series 2009A and the \$21,590,000 Cleveland County Justice Authority Sales Tax Revenue Bonds (Cleveland County Justice Authority Sales Tax Revenue Bonds (Cleveland County Justice Authority Sales Tax Revenue Bonds (Cleveland County Detention Facility Project) Series 2009B; to establish a reserve fund, if any and pay costs of issuance related thereto (herein "Project") and all other matters related thereto, including but not limited to the waiver of competitive bidding thereof; and approving and authorizing the execution and delivery of related documents including, but not limited to the Lease Agreement, hiring professionals, and the taking of all action in connection therewith. ## C. Items of Business:

 Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to approve the Agreement for Services between the Cleveland County Health Department and the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma on behalf of Department of Pediatrics. The Health Department will provide the University a Program Coordinator for the Early Foundations Program, hourly teaching assistance for each child under the age of 3 years, and purchase classroom materials and general supplies necessary to implement and maintain the Early Foundations Program for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015 in an amount paid by the University not to exceed \$20,000.00.
