MINUTES

APRIL 6, 2015

Rhett Burnett led in Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners was called to order this 6th day of April 2015 in the meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Darry Stacy. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called rolled and those present were:
