### **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S**

### **MINUTES**

**JULY 25, 2016** 

Rod Cleveland led in prayer and pledge of allegiance.

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners was called to order this 25th day of July 2016 in the meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Harold Haralson. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

Vice-Chairman Darry Stacy was absent.
