MINUTES

MONDAY, AUGUST 21, 2017

Linda Atkins led in Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Darry Stacy called to order the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners at 1:00 P.M. this 21st day of August 2017 in meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

After the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of **August 14, 2017** and there being no additions or corrections, Harold Haralson moved to **approve**. Rod Cleveland seconded the motion.

- **D.** During **Commissioner's discussions** about County Business, Commissioner Haralson said that his heart goes out to the families of the ten missing Navy sailors and the five that were injured when a United States destroyer collided with an oil tanker off the coast of Singapore.

(At this point Carol Cline entered the meeting.)

Chairman Stacy invited Carol Cline to present the **CIRB Report.**Ms. Cline said she has copies for the Board of the Cleveland County CIRB Allocation Plan SFY 2017 which is a five-year plan. They've taken the encumbered amount since the start of CIRB and deducted it from what their proceeds were and the \$150,000,000 that the legislatures taken on the transfers. The first project, on the bridge over Willow Creek, has a change since their last plan because it was not encumbered in the year 2017. It will come out of the year 2018 encumbrance. She also applied the BR funds to it from the last visit. Looking at the top of the page at the 2018 year encumbrance, it shows how it will carry over in the amount of \$1,023,209.85. Some counties are in the hole because of the \$150,000,000 taken out and were a million in the hole. She said it is the Board's prerogative to make changes since there is a \$71,000 deficient. She assured that it is not a huge problem because

the Board can leave one year from one of the \$50,000,000 years in the plan. She

finished by saying that this is the Board's plan and encouraged them to check the particular projects and to go over them one by one if desired. She stressed that the Commissioners take all the time they need to review the Plan because there is no urgency to approve today.

Discussion was had to place this item on the next agenda.
