MINUTES

MONDAY, AUGUST 28, 2017

Jacob McHughes led in Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Darry Stacy called to order the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners at 1:00 P.M. this 28th day of August 2017 in meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

After the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of **August 21, 2017** and there being no additions or corrections, Harold Haralson moved to **approve**. Rod Cleveland seconded the motion.

The term of agreement is July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
