MINUTES

MONDAY, JANUARY 8, 2018 ---

Commissioner Rod Cleveland led in Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Darry Stacy called to order the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners at 1:00 P.M. this 8th day of January 2018 in meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:
