

### **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S**

#### **MINUTES**

## MONDAY, MARCH 12, 2018

John Roberts led in Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Darry Stacy called to order the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners at 1:00 P.M. this 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 2018 in meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

#### B. Old Business:

1. Computer Aided Dispatch Software (CAD), Jail Management Software (JMS), Fire Records Management Software (Fire RMS), and mobile components for each of these software packages.
