The term of this Contract shall begin on the 26th Day of December and will continue from year to year unless otherwise terminated by either party or modified by mutual Contract.
- 5. Memorandum of Agreement between Cleveland County Board of County Commissioners and the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma for the use of the Cleveland County Fairgrounds as East Emergency Evacuation Site for Students.
