## **MINUTES**

## **TUESDAY, JANUARY 22, 2019**

Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance were led by Chief of Operations Jose Chavez.

Chairman Rod Cleveland called to order the regular scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners at 1:00 P.M. this 22nd day of January 2019 in meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:
