

## **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

## **MONDAY OCTOBER 21, 2019**

Rod Cleveland led in Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Harold Haralson called to order the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Cleveland County Commissioners at 1:00 P.M. this 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 2019 in meeting Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building. Tammy Belinson, County Clerk/Secretary, called the roll and those present were:
