- 3. Maintenance Agreement between Board of County Commissioners on behalf of Cleveland County Justice Center and Cox Communications for the Voice Manager Essential Package in the amount of \$72.00 per month effective January 7, 2020.
- 4. Preventative Maintenance Agreement between Board of County Commissioners on behalf of Cleveland County Health Department and Allied Refrigeration for annual maintenance of Helmer Refrigerators/Freezer located at 250 12th Ave., NE Norman.
