Commissioner Stacy bid farewell to Assistant District Attorney Abby Nathan who is moving on to the next endeavor in her life and welcomed her replacement Assistant District Attorney Nathan Hale.

Discussion was had on the ACOG Regional Transit Authority and the RTA and how it relates to COPTA.

- G. There being no further business to come before the Board, Darry Stacy moved, seconded by Rod Cleveland, that the meeting is adjourned at 1:18 P.M.
