MINUTES

TUESDAY, JULY 10, 2018

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Community Corrections Planning Council was called to order at 8:30 am this 10th day of July 2018 in the Conference Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Dave Stockwell. Linda Atkins, Deputy County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

Others present were: Thomas Sasser, Debi Cox, Greg Stroud, Travis White, Janet Langley and Melvina Garcia.

Chairman Dave Stockwell asked if the meeting complied with the **Open Meeting Act**. Linda Atkins answered affirmatively.

After the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of **April 10, 2018**, and there being no additions or corrections, Darry Stacy moved that the minutes be approved.

Judge Jeff Virgin seconded the motion.

Chairman Stockwell introduced Ed Copelin, who is Judge Jeff Virgin's selection to fill the positions vacated in 2015 by Libba Smith. He said that Mr. Copelin is well-known by all members of the Board because he owns Copelin's Office Supply and Kadoodles. He said that his acquaintance with Mr. Copelin goes back several years and thanked him for accepting Judge Virgin's invitation to fill the vacancy on the Board and for serving the community as he is doing already. The swear-in was performed by Chairman Stockwell.

(Clerk's Note: The official swearing in is scheduled for the next meeting, October 9, 2018, as an agenda item to appoint Ed Copelin and sign the Loyalty Oath.)

A. Items of Business:

1. Following a brief discussion, Darry Stacy moved, seconded by Judge Jeff Virgin, to **approve** for fiscal year **2019** using up to \$5000 of **210 Administrative Fee Funds** for GED testing fees, bus passes, AA/NA recognition items, housing deposits, tuition, other pro-social items, and 2 computers for participant use for actions such as job applications, GED preparation, computer training, and job searches.

JULY 10, 2018

1. P.O. repeatedly attempts to contact the client by mail, telephone, and in person by conducting home visits //for approximately 30 days.
2. P.O. checks local jails and hospitals.
3. P.O. contacts family, friends and employers requesting them to pass along the message to contact their P.O.
4. After 30 days, P.O. files a violation report to the Court requesting that a warrant be issued due to the fact that the client has gone AWOL.
5. P.O. confirms that the active warrant has been posted in NCIC. If it is not posted, P.O. writes a letter requesting that the warrant be entered into NCIC.
6. Quarterly, P.O. requests additional NCIC reports to ensure that the client has not been arrested in another town or state.




