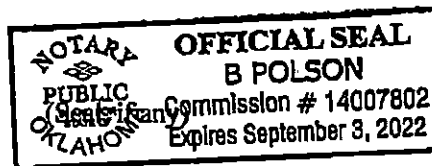



4. **Deborah Cox gave a Report on current fiscal year budget, expenditures, sentencing** and program information updates. She said they are sitting at \$65,881.60. They are running low with their numbers, with sixty-five actual right now and they've had nine sentenced since the beginning of this Fiscal Year. There are 20 LSI ordered since July 1, 2018. The 210 Fund is \$49,994.00 and is used to enhance the programing for whatever is seen fit. She reminded them that as far as program growth, that on November 1<sup>st</sup>, the Community Sentencing statute changes. It will no longer be necessary to have a felony prior to be eligible for the program; felons with zero priors will be eligible for funding as long as the LSI score is 19-54.

Chairman Stockwell asked how are they doing state-wide and are they losing people to go in this program.

Deborah Cox said she has not seen a decrease and at one time they did have 100 people.

Chairman Stockwell said it's been the goal for 18 years.

Deborah Cox said the bills are paid.

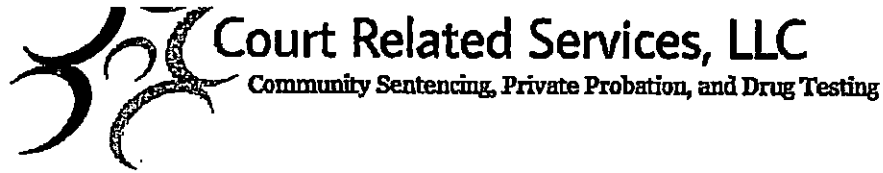

- Greg Mashburn, District Attorney**, said he did not have the exact numbers for July, August and September 2018 activity of Community Sentencing in the District Attorney's Office. He said that Thomas Sasser is having a struggle to keep people in the court. It is going to help with the zero priors opening up and the legislators were asked to help to get these in treatment sooner that will help to try to catch these people before they become convicted felons in our program, but we are having no success and less people are getting treatment now than they were before. Statewide, many of the District Attorneys are struggling to keep their drug courts open. They have a lack of participation because people will take county jail time over wanting to change their lives. He said they will try to get people in the programs without carrying a big stick approach by continuing to keep pushing.
- Melvina Garcia presented an overview of Court Related Services** to include an absconder status report. Mrs. Garcia introduced DOC Officer Dawn Thatcher.

1. P.O. repeatedly attempts to contact the client by mail, telephone, and in person by conducting home visits /for approximately 30 days.
2. P.O. checks local jails and hospitals.
3. P.O. contacts family, friends and employers requesting them to pass along the message to contact their P.O.
4. After 30 days, P.O. files a violation report to the Court requesting that a warrant be issued due to the fact that the client has gone AWOL.
5. P.O. confirms that the active warrant has been posted in NCIC. If it is not posted, P.O. writes a letter requesting that the warrant be entered into NCIC.
6. Quarterly, P.O. requests additional NCIC reports to ensure that the client has not been arrested in another town or state.


