Notice is hereby given that the <u>Cleveland County Board of Equalization</u> shall be in session at Norman, Oklahoma, 201 South Jones, Suite 200, (Cleveland County Office Building), commencing on the <u>4th Tuesday in January, 2019</u>, (January 22, 2019) at the hour of <u>9:45 A. M.</u> for the purpose of equalization, correcting and adjusting the assessment rolls of said county to conform to the fair cash value of the property, as defined by law, and shall continue from day to day until concluded but each session shall not continue beyond the hour of <u>5:00 P. M.</u> on the <u>31st day of May, 2019</u>.

4. During the organizational meeting and review of forms and procedures, Bobby Cleveland inquired about Item No. 10. He said that in the past the Board Members divided the appeals among the members and then go look at the properties under protest. He asked if that is still the practice. He said the home owner was not contacted, but they did drive by to look at the property.

Assistant District Attorney Jim Robertson stated that the problem is in the communication with the owner, not driving by and looking at the property. He added that, as a board member, they cannot go with other members, but there is nothing wrong with driving by to become familiar with the property. He added that in his opinion Item No. 10 is going to be accurate, but it can be modified later on if needed.

It was discussed that packets will no longer be provided to the Board prior to the meeting. The Board will receive the agenda and the minutes of the last meeting as usual. All protesters are required to have an Informal Appeal with the County Assessor before filing the Formal Appeal. The County Assessor will state on the Decision of the Informal Appeal the reason for change or no change.

Bobby Cleveland moved, seconded by Larry Heikkila to accept the County Board of Equalization Hearing Procedure.

On the 22rd day of January 2019, the Cleveland County Board of Equalization discussed and reviewed the forms and procedures for the ensuing year.

Therefore, the Board approved using the same procedures as last year and a copy is attached hereto and made part of the minutes.
